The Opening Ceremony will take place on Thursday 6 June, at 18:15 at the venue.

Victory Ceremonies:

The Victory Ceremonies will take place on the Victory Ceremony pontoon in the finish area. Victory Ceremonies will be held after each race.

Awards:

The overall winner of the Olympic Hopes Regatta 2019 is the V4 federation scoring the most points in the races and will receive the Olympic Hopes Regatta 2019 Cup.

The V4 federation scoring the most points in men’s events will receive the overall Olympic Hopes Men’s Cup 2019.

The V4 federation scoring the most points in women’s events will receive the overall Olympic Hopes Women’s Cup 2019.

Scores (only the “A” crews of the V4 federations will score points as detailed below):

- 6 entries 7-5-4-3-2-1
- 5 entries 6-4-3-2-1
- 4 entries 5-3-2-1
- 3 entries 4-2-1
- 2 entries 3-1

Medals: Crews finishing 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each Final A will receive medals.

Special notes:

Due to the preparational works of World Masters Rowing Regatta (11th – 15th September, 2019) some part of the venue is under construction. Please be aware of it and pay special attention to the security of everyone.

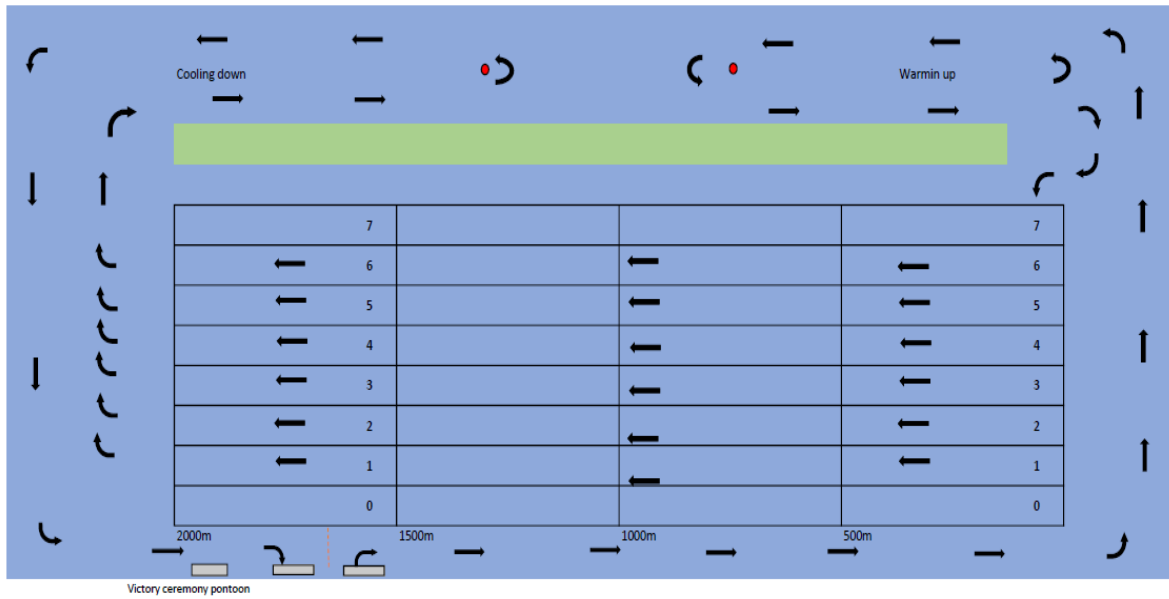


Venue maps

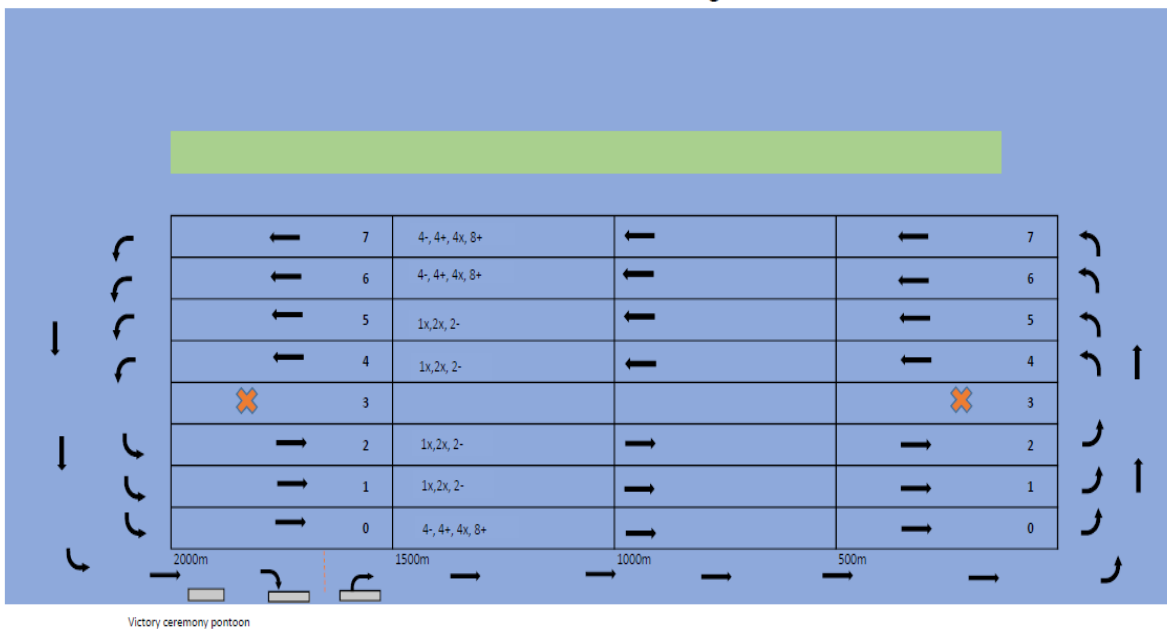




Traffic Rules - Racing
